Breeders Group viz any breed consisting of three animals bred by the Exhibitor, both sexes to be represented and all owned by Exhibitor. Exhibits must be entered in the General Classes, any age.

Exhibitors please note: No bedding available

- 1 The age of Beef Cattle and Prime cattle to be the actual age up to and inclusive of the 1st May each year.
- 2 Full particulars must be stated on entry form, including the breed, sex and date of birth of each animal.
- 3 A heifer is defined as being under 2 years old and as yet not had a calf.
- 4 No staining or colouring of horns or skin of any animal entered for the show is allowed.
- 5 **All cattle that are entered in led classes, which are not thoroughly tractable to leads, will not be admitted to the ground.**
- 6 All bulls, 12 months and over, must have rings and be provided with leads and all females, except Prime Cattle, must be provided with strong halter and be thoroughly broken to lead.
- 7 Judges to be instructed that all cases of doubtful ages, shall be referred by them to the Chief Steward before awards are made. The age of Stud cattle shall be governed by the certificate issued by the Breeds Society with which the animal is registered. Where a doubt is raised concerning the age of Prime Cattle, the definition will be taken of a calf registration certificate issued by the Breed Society with which the animal is registered.
- 8 No animal, whether male or female, shall be eligible for exhibition except in Prime Cattle classes, if it is not registered.
- 9 In awarding the Championship, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative sub-section shall be eligible to compete.
- 10 Exhibits shall remain on exhibition until 4pm on Show Day.
- 11 In all classes three ribbons may be awarded at the discretion of the Judge.
- 12 No animal shall be admitted to the Judging ring during the judging of any class, unless it is an exhibit in such class, but a calf of an exhibit in the Beef classes may be admitted if it is under the age of seven months and is being suckled by the exhibit.
- 13 No animal entered in any Breed Section, registered or unregistered, is eligible to compete in the Prime Cattle section or vice versa.

- 14 Registered owners can exhibit registered cattle in Led section and unregistered in Prime section.
- 15 The decision of the Chief Steward is final.
- 16 All exhibits to be delivered to the Stewards by 9am on Saturday .
- 17 All entries **MUST** be accompanied by a "Cattle Health Status Declaration for Show & Sales". (See enclosed Form)
- 18 Exhibitors must sign Waiver before entering.
- 19 Exhibitors to supply own bedding.
- 20 **All cattle to be NLIS tagged.**
